Your child does not need to start over if one or more vaccines are missed - just speak with a provider about a catch up schedule.

1. NBS (Newborn Screen) is a blood test looking for hormone, blood, genetic, and metabolic conditions in newborns.
2. ASQ (Ages & Stages Questionnaire) is a questionnaire designed to help identify developmental delays.
3. Vision screen is performed using a device that captures an image of child's eyes identifying several vision abnormalities.
4. MCHAT (Modified Checklist for Autism in Toddlers) is a questionnaire designed to help identify children at risk for autism spectrum disorder.
5. Pentacel is a combination vaccine containing DTaP, IPV, and Hib. Children receive one dose of all three vaccines in just one injection.

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
